We are so glad you have chosen the Alford Youth & Community Center to host your special occasion rental! Our main goal is for everyone to have fun, but of course, we do need to assure the safety of everyone within our facility. Here are a few ground rules. PARTY DETAILS GUESTS USING PLAYLAND EQUIPMENT CANNOT EXCEED 25 PERSONS

- The first hour of the rental is for set-up while the children play in Adventure Playland. The second hour takes place in the private party room.
- The rental party is provided with 25 passes for the bounce house, climbing wall and play structure for up to 25 children, ages 12 and under.
- Socks are required for all children utilizing the bounce houses. Socks can be purchased at the Welcome Center for \$1.00 per pair.
- All belongings should be placed in the party room.
- Each guest parent must check-in with the Welcome Center to receive bracelets for attendance.
- The AYCC provides a private party room with two 8-foot long tables and chairs for party guests.

Pizza and beverages may be purchased in addition to the cost of the party. They will arrive at the 2nd hour of the specified party room time. If additional pizza is requested, the order must be called into the Welcome Center by 12:00pm on the Friday afternoon prior to the party.

SAFETY

- The bounce houses and play structures are for children age 12 and under. Please adhere to ages listed on the bounce equipment.
- Going behind the equipment is prohibited.
- Should an inflatable begin losing air, the equipment MUST be exited immediately.
- Any accidents/injuries should be immediately reported to the Playland Attendant on duty.
- Use all equipment appropriately. Use slide appropriately; bottom down, feet first. No jumping, no going head first, and no climbing up the slide or the sides. Only the ladder is to be used for climbing.
- The obstacle course is one-way only, beginning with the back of the course. No bouncing in the tunnel and no stopping in the middle.
- No climbing on the sides of any equipment.
- Climbing Wall may only be used with an attendant's guidance. Users are required to wear socks and shoes. and must be appropriately clipped and harnessed by staff.

These rules are for the safety of you and the children in the Adventure Playland. We hope that you respect our effort to keep a safe environment. If the rules are not followed, the Playland Attendant may ask that your child refrain from utilizing our equipment and/or be asked to leave.

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RENTAL CONTRACT RESPONSIBILITY

- Full payment for the rental is required at the time of booking. The contact person listed on the rental contract is liable for their guests and for any damages to the facility which may result in additional fees.
- This person is also responsible for the cleanliness of the party room spaces and will be expected to assure all trash is placed appropriately in trash receptacles and the general cleanliness of the room is maintained. The AYCC's housekeeping staff does a quick sweep, wipe of tables and trash removal in between parties. Excessive messes left by the party will be billed to the contracted party contact.
- At least one adult must be with the children providing appropriate supervision during the entirety of the party. The Alford Youth & Community Center staff are not responsible for the children during the party.
- The named contact for the rental contract is responsible for the safety and behavior of all party guests in attendance.
- The Alford Youth & Community Center and its staff are not responsible for supervision of children, or for lost/stolen items.
- The kitchen and the use of kitchen tools and supplies without contracted permission is unacceptable. Ice machine usage must be approved by Welcome Center staff prior to usage.
- No candles or other items causing smoke can be used in the facility.
- Rental parties are responsible for providing paper and plastic products such as tablecloths, plates, napkins, cups, and utensils.
- Refunds will only be given if 48 hours or more notice is given. There will be a processing fee of \$10.00. Rescheduling of a party can take place, depending on space available. See www.clubaycc.org/refunds for our full refund policy.

GENERAL FACILITY RULES

- Anyone entering the facility must complete an AYCC liability waiver to be kept on file.
- All guests must sign in at the Welcome Center
- NO smoking/vaping is allowed on the AYCC grounds (including the parking lot). No drugs or alcohol are permitted on AYCC property, including marijuana.

DECORATIONS

- The use of confetti, glitter bombs, or other messy party supplies are strictly prohibited in the facility.
- No packing/duct tape, thumb tacks, nails or other methods of attaching decorations to the walls is allowed. Removal of AYCC artwork or wall décor is prohibited. Please see the Welcome Center staff if you would like to hang items.
- Decorations, gifts and belongings should be removed from the party room at the end of the specified party contract time. Trash should be placed in the trash cans provided by the AYCC.
