AYCC SWIMMING POOL RULES

We are so glad you have chosen the Alford Youth & Community Center to host your special occasion rental! Our main goal is for everyone to have fun, but of course, we do need to assure the safety of everyone within our facility. Here are a few ground rules. POOL PARTY RULES

- Swimming allowed only when Lifeguard is present.
- Shower before entering pool.
- Shoulder-length hair must be tied up or secured under swim cap.
- Infants must wear a swim diaper and appropriate swim wear.
- Children must pass deep end swim test to enter deep end and/or use Climbing Wall.
- Two climbers at a time on the climbing wall.
- Basic swim tests will be administered by Lifeguards on Duty to determine which part of the pool a child is able to utilize safely.
- Dives, spinning and/or flipping jumps into the pool are not permitted.
- Please jump feet first only in areas of 4.5 foot depth and higher.
- Prolonged underwater swimming/breath-holding is not allowed.
- Play on bleachers, railings, lane line or other pool fixtures is unsafe and is not allowed. Starting blocks are only for swim team use and under the guidance of a certified swim coach.
- Rough play and/or fighting is not allowed.
- Swimmers may use noodles and toys, but not water aerobics equipment.
- Walk at all times in aquatics areas.
- Do not play or climb on railings in pool area. Go around, not under.
- Ceramic and glass containers prohibited in pool area.
- Children under six (6) years of age and/or those using flotation devices must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices are allowed.
- Lifeguard on duty is authorized with discretion to enforce all pool rules.

AYCC GENERAL FACILITY RULES

RENTAL CONTRACT RESPONSIBILITY

- Full payment for the rental is required at the time of booking. The contact person listed on the rental contract is liable for their guests and for any damages to the facility which may result in additional fees.
- This person is also responsible for the cleanliness of the party room spaces and will be expected to assure all trash is placed appropriately in trash receptacles and the general cleanliness of the room is maintained. The AYCC's housekeeping staff does a quick sweep, wipe of tables and trash removal in between parties. Excessive messes left by the party will be billed to the contracted party contact.
- At least one adult must be with the children providing appropriate supervision during the entirety of the party. The Alford Youth & Community Center staff are not responsible for the children during the party.
- The named contact for the rental contract is responsible for the safety and behavior of all party guests in attendance.
- The Alford Youth & Community Center and its staff are not responsible for supervision of children, or for lost/stolen items.
- The kitchen and the use of kitchen tools and supplies without contracted permission is unacceptable. Ice machine usage must be approved by Welcome Center staff prior to usage.
- No candles or other items causing smoke can be used in the facility.
- Rental parties are responsible for providing paper and plastic products such as tablecloths, plates, napkins, cups, and utensils.
- Refunds will only be given if 48 hours or more notice is given. There will be a processing fee of \$10.00. Rescheduling of a party can take place, depending on space available. See www.clubaycc.org/refunds for our full refund policy.

GENERAL FACILITY RULES

- Anyone entering the facility must complete an AYCC liability waiver to be kept on file.
- All guests must sign in at the Welcome Center
- NO smoking/vaping is allowed on the AYCC grounds (including the parking lot). No drugs or alcohol are permitted on AYCC property, including marijuana.
- Rough housing, fighting, wrestling, violence and inappropriate acts are prohibited, whether physical or verbal.

DECORATIONS

- The use of confetti, glitter bombs, or other messy party supplies are strictly prohibited in the facility.
- No packing/duct tape, thumb tacks, nails or other methods of attaching decorations to the walls is allowed. Removal of AYCC artwork or wall décor is prohibited. Please see the Welcome Center staff if you would like to hang items.
- Decorations, gifts and belongings should be removed from the party room at the end of the specified party contract time. Trash should be placed in the trash cans provided by the AYCC.
