Waterville, ME – Monday, August 25, 2025 – The Alfond Youth & Community Center (AYCC) is proud to announce its participation in the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Child and Adult Food Care Program (CACFP). Through this program, nutritious meals are available at **no separate charge** to all children enrolled at the AYCC.

This program helps ensure that every child in our community has access to healthy, balanced meals that support their growth, learning, and overall well-being – regardless of family income.
